MULTI-USE GAMES AREA

The City of York Council aims to install a Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA), comprising metal goal ends and an artificial playing surface. One of the proposed locations is the small football pitch at STRAY Road Park. Responding to feedback and discussions with various residents, HWPC does **NOT** wish the MUGA to be installed in the park. This is an area of the park where people come to enjoy the open grass and natural setting, surrounded by wildlife and trees. The artificial playing surface would take up most of the current football pitch and change the character of our well-established, family-friendly green park.

All residents now have the chance to decide about this. We include a **questionnaire** which it is vital everyone answers and returns to us.

SPRING GARDENING COMPETITION

We'll be holding our 1st Springtime Gardening Competition in Spring 2023. There will be two categories:

- 1. Best Front Garden.
- 2. Best front of house container/basket/window box display.

Free Entry; all Parish properties automatically entered. The aim is to encourage and reward front garden and front of house gardening that enhances the local scene and brings happiness and inspiration to our neighbours.

We are looking for evidence of:

- Use of plants to bring colour and form to a front garden and front of house area.
- Sustainable gardening practice.
- Promoting wildlife.

Judging will be in late April 2023 by HWPC and several representatives from our local gardening group, **Burnholme Gardening Club**, who run events through the year including an informative and encouraging programme of talks by experts.
